Description

This 40 hour course is structured to provide Public Safety Dispatchers with the operational skills to function as an integral support component of Critical Incident operations. Course curriculum topics include:

Focus will be on the role, duties and responsibilities of the Public Safety Tactical Dispatcher Team operating in the department's Incident Command post or the Communications Center. Training will be conducted using an extensive model city, videos and mock command post operational problems to simulate actual events and tactical communication procedures.
